

Interpreting Your Ski Mountaineering Competition CANADA CUP POINTS Total

These are what they seem – an individual athlete’s collection of points according to their 4 best race results over the SMCC calendar season. These are awarded to each competitor based on their finishing position in each race. Note that some ‘events’ comprise more than one race: e.g. a Sprint and a Vertical in the same place, on the same weekend, count as two different races.

1st place – 100 points

2nd place – 80 points

3rd place – 60 points

4th place – 50 points

5th place – 45 points

6th place – 40 points

7th place – 36 points

8th place – 32 points

9th place – 29 points

10th place – 24 points

11th place – 22 points

12th and descending places – 20, 18, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12... points

After the final event of the calendar, a winner of the Canada Cup is declared.

Now we just need a cup to award!
